STAGE ONE (Grades K - 2)

Let your little performer shine! This class provides a unique opportunity for young children to develop skills as musicians and actors. Students will be introduced to the art of choral singing, drama and movement. Music theory instruction will include note reading, sight singing and musical terminology. Drama instruction will include activities in imagination, concentration, transformation and imitation. Each and every class will be a high-energy, fun journey for the young performer. Guest teachers from the Chorale staff will also share their expertise during the choral singing time. At the conclusion of the semester, there will be an "informance" to display student achievement. Performers who have demonstrated exceptional skill and focus will be invited to audition for the CSCC training choir in second grade.

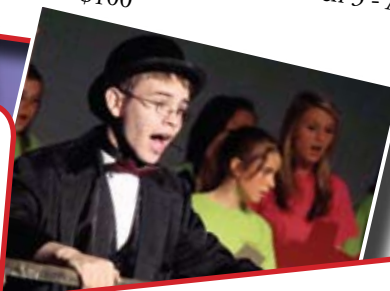


ACT ONE (Grades 2 - 5)

Is the Big Bad Wolf really so bad? Where do you find magic beans? And what was in that gingerbread recipe? These questions and many more intriguing inquiries will be answered in this semester's theatre course, "Fairytale Fling!" This eight-week course explores the dramatic possibilities hidden behind some of our greatest children's stories. Students will develop skills in concentration, transformation, characterization and improvisation. This is the perfect opportunity for young performers to take a romp through the world of theatre. There will be a sharing time on the last day of class. This semester we offer two class choices for this group: Fairytale Fling (repeats last semester material) and Drama Worlds.

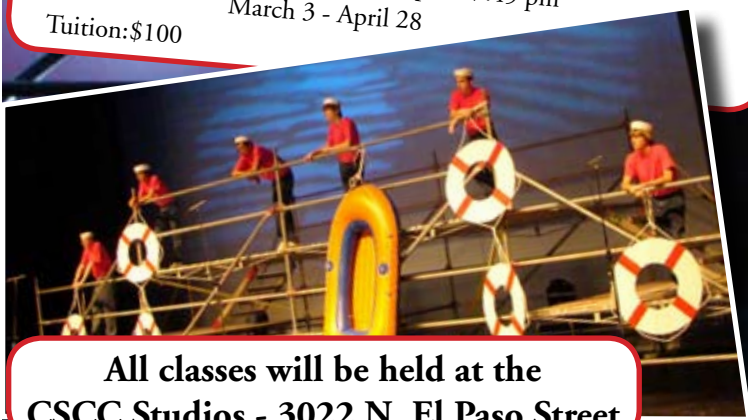


ACT TWO (Grades 6 - 8)

This imaginative course will offer a doorway into some rich traditional tales of yesteryear in this semester's theatre course "Folktale Favorites". Students will develop skills in concentration, transformation, characterization, improvisation and scene structure. This actors' workshop will emphasize an expression of skills rather than performance product. This is a fabulous preparatory class for young performers looking to expand his or her skills in the world of dramatic performance. A perfect training ground for those interested in pursuing school or community musicals. There will be a sharing time on the last day of class.

STUDIO ONE (Grades 9 - 12)

This unique course is designed for the high school student who is interested in elevating their individual artistry to a professional level. In a collegiate format, each class will be devoted to different topics integral to the maturing performer. The course will cover the audition process including resume writing, headshots and song & monologue selection. There will also be an introduction to theatrical dance. Students will have the opportunity to acquire techniques essential to a developing artist. Guest speakers will enhance this workshop with their insight into the world of performance. Individual vocal and theatrical coaching will be included in this ten-week session as well as participation in an ensemble piece. This course requires a highly dedicated student as individual rehearsal will be critical to artistic success. There will be a recital to showcase student work at the end of the session. Each student will also leave the course with a professional resume and headshot.
