- May 1** **Southern Colorado In Harmony Elementary Choir Festival rehearsal** at the Pikes Peak Center – enter through the backstage entrance. Carpooling or parent/friend drop-off is highly recommended as parking is metered all around the Pikes Peak Center now. **This is a required outreach event.**  
**Arrive:** 3:30 pm – *eat a good snack before you come*  
**Pick-Up:** 6:45 pm  
**Uniform:** SING Camp Shirt, Chorale-appropriate jeans (Medium blue, plain, no holes, rips or decorations), white socks/white tennis shoes, Chorale jacket  
**Bring:** A water bottle with your name on it and your music folder

**Arrive:** 3:30 pm  
**Rehearsal:** 3:30-5:30 pm

**Perform:** 7:00 pm  
**Pick-Up:** 9:00 pm (pickup from the backstage entrance)  
**Uniform:** Formal-Red dresses/character shoes, gray pants, white shirt, navy blazer/blk dress shoes  
**Bring:** Water bottle with your name on it. **DO NOT** bring your music folder.  
**Parents,** you are welcome to come and bring guests to this performance. The concert will feature the Pikes Peak Singers and showcase the work that all of the singers from throughout the community will do with special clinician, Kate Klotz from Boulder!
